LIEUTENANT COLONEL RAYMOND KING
MUNDY'S MILL HIGH SCHOOL AFJROTC INSTRUCTOR**

- WHEREAS:** The Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFJROTC) at Mundy's Mill High School was established in 2005 under the leadership of Lt. Colonel Raymond King; and
- WHEREAS:** The Mundy's Mill High School AFJROTC Program supplies students with knowledge to prepare them for military, collegiate, work force skills in the areas of aerospace science, leadership, education, drill and ceremonies, aviation history, global cultural studies, financial management, and extreme excellence challenge in physical fitness; and
- WHEREAS:** Under the direction and close guidance of Colonel King, the AFJROTC at Mundy's Mill High School has been awarded Distinguished Unit for four consecutive years as well as Distinguished Unit with Merit. In 2012 the Mundy's Mill High School AFJROTC Drill Team captured the title of Georgia State Drill Champions; and
- WHEREAS:** This honor places Mundy's Mill High School AFJROTC Program in the top 10% of over 800 Units across the continental United States and Overseas. The cadets have been labeled the most noteworthy, respectful, and knowledgeable Cadets in all of the Clayton County AFJROTC Programs. The AFJROTC Cadet program boasts nearly 400 cadets who are true leaders in the school, taking on various community service projects along with their grueling practice schedule, and academic commitments. The Mundy's Mill High School AFJROTC is also known for annually having one or several cadets to receive congressional Military Academy Nominations; and
- WHEREAS:** The success of the Mundy's Mill AFJROTC Program would not be possible without each of the dedicated Cadets and most importantly the instruction, commitment, passion and leadership of Colonel Raymond King. His drive for advancing the Clayton County Public Schools AFJROTC Programs is recognized by his fellow AFJROTC instructors in the state of Georgia, the Clayton County School System, and the faculty and staff of Mundy's Mill High School. In a phrase coined by principal William C. Greene Jr., Colonel King's work at the school helps to make Mundy's Mill High School "World Famous"; and
- WHEREAS:** Prior to becoming a high school AFJROTC Instructor, Colonel King served twenty two distinguished years in the United States Air Force as a Master Aviator with over three thousand hours of flight time. Lt. Colonel King retired in 2000 from Ft. McPherson after completing a Special Duty assignment as Chief of The Air Force National Security Emergency Preparedness Division; and
- WHEREAS:** The Clayton County Board of Commissioners is proud to honor and acknowledge the many outstanding accomplishments and opportunities that Lt. Colonel Raymond King has afforded hundreds of Clayton County Students throughout the years. Many who are currently enrolled in or have successfully completed college, the military service or military academy. We honor his outstanding service and dedication to the United States Air Force, his commitment to his country and the citizens of Clayton County; now
