RESOLUTION NO. 2010-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE 2010 CENSUS COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, every decade since 1790, the U.S. Census Bureau has conducted a constitutionally mandated census to accurately reflect the number of people living within the United States and its territories; and

WHEREAS, the census data is used to make vital decisions including redistricting and reallocation of federal funds; and

WHEREAS, one of the major goals of the 2010 Census is to increase the national mail back response rate, which not only reduces the overall cost of the census, but it also increases the accuracy of the data as well; and

WHEREAS, the Complete Count Committee (the "Committee") is a key component for planning and implementing local, targeted efforts that will address the unique make-up of the County for census accuracy and will work to increase the mail back response; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners agrees that it is appropriate to establish a Complete Count Committee consisting of members from business, community and civic leaders, education, media, faith-based organization and others who shall work to increase awareness about the census and motivate residents in the community to respond; and

WHEREAS, the makeup of the Committee will reflect the diversity of the citizens in Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners feels that it is in the best interests of Clayton County to establish the Complete Count Committee for reasons set forth above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2010 Census Complete Count Committee. The Board hereby designates Kim Siebert to serve as Chairperson of the Committee and directs that she utilize various resources such as the Extension Service, Clayton County Grassroots, Archway, the 4 H Clubs and other community and religious organizations to recruit volunteers to make up a committee that reflects the diversity of the citizens of Clayton County. Further, Ms. Siebert should work with the designated Federal 2010 Census Officials assigned to Clayton County to help ensure that all citizens of the County are counted. Further, the Committee shall function under the recommended guidelines of the U. S Census Bureau.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




