

RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE GEORGIA BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION TO UPGRADE THE AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM EQUIPMENT AS PART OF A HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT, TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED IN THE TERMS OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation and the Georgia Emergency Management Agency have obtained a grant from Homeland Security to upgrade the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (hereinafter "AFIS") to improve its functionality as a valuable law enforcement tool; and

WHEREAS, the County's Police Department has AFIS equipment that is eligible for upgrading under this grant at no additional cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into this Memorandum of Understanding to upgrade the existing AFIS equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS
HEREBY RESOLVED

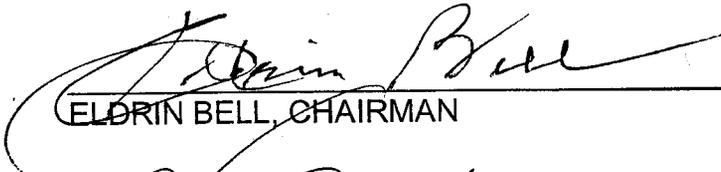
Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Eldrin Bell, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation and the Georgia Emergency Management Agency to replace existing Automated Fingerprint Identification System equipment to facilitate a state wide effort to improve functionality of this valuable law enforcement tool. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

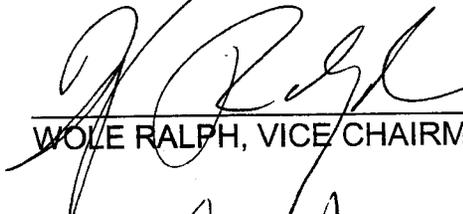
Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

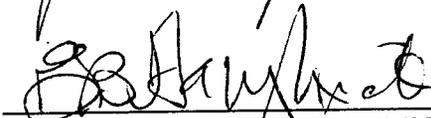

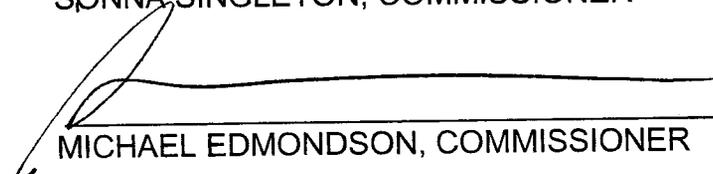
