RESOLUTION 2011 – 180

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ADOPT THE 2011 CLAYTON COUNTY SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY WITH THE CITIES OF COLLEGE PARK, FOREST PARK, JONESBORO, LAKE CITY, LOVEJOY MORROW, RIVERDALE AND THE CLAYTON COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. Title 36, Chapter 70, Sections 20 through 28, each County and Municipality is required to execute an agreement for the implementation of a local government service delivery strategy; and

WHEREAS, representatives of Clayton County, the Cities of College Park, Forest Park, Jonesboro, Lake City, Lovejoy, Morrow, Riverdale and the Clayton County Water Authority have discussed the implementation of such an agreement; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 Clayton County Service Delivery Strategy (“Strategy”) constitutes such an agreement and promotes the delivery of local government services in the most efficient, effective, and responsive manner for all residents, individual and property owners throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by adopting the Strategy for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the 2011 Clayton County Service Delivery Strategy with the Cities of College Park, Forest Park, Jonesboro, Lake City, Lovejoy, Morrow, Riverdale and the Clayton County Water Authority to be effective upon approval and execution by the requisite number of cities and continuing until December 31, 2012.




Section 3. The effective date of this Resolution shall be when approved by the Clayton County Board of Commissioners.




