RESOLUTION NO. 2012 – 217

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY TO USE FORT GILLEM AS THE SITE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATIONS COURSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE LICENSE, GENERAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Georgia's Peace Officer Standards and Training Council mandates that all police recruits must successfully complete an Emergency Vehicle Operations Course (EVOC) to be certified as Georgia peace officers; and

WHEREAS, the EVOC site normally used by the Police Department is temporarily unavailable; and

WHEREAS, the United States Secretary of the Army, through his representative at Fort Gillem, has agreed to allow the Police Department to use Fort Gillem for EVOC training at no cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by approving the use of the Fort Gillem facility for EVOC training.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a License Agreement with the Secretary of the Army, to execute a General Release of Liability and to execute a Certificate of Authority for the purpose of allowing the Police Department to conduct its Emergency Vehicle Operations Course at Fort Gillem. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman or the Chief of Police as his designee, to execute the License, Release of Liability and Certificate of Authority and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


