ORDINANCE NO. 2015-115

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART II, CHAPTER 94 “TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES”, ARTICLE III “PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING”, BY REPEALING AND DELETING THE EXISTING SUBSECTION (C) OF SECTION 94-60 “PROHIBITED PARKING OF A VEHICLE WITHIN THE FRONT YARD” AND SUBSTITUTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SUBSECTION (C) OF SECTION 94-60 “PROHIBITED PARKING OF A VEHICLE WITHIN THE FRONT YARD”; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part II, Chapter 94 “Traffic and Vehicles”, Article III “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, by repealing and deleting the existing subsection (c) of Section 94-60 “Prohibited parking of a vehicle within the front yard” and substituting in lieu thereof a new subsection (c) of Section 94-60 “Prohibited parking of a vehicle within the front yard” to read as follows:

“Sec. 94-60. – Prohibited parking of a vehicle within the front yard.

(c) Inspectors of the community development department, law enforcement officers and code enforcement officers of the police department are authorized to issue a summons returnable to the magistrate court to the owner or possessor of the real

property, or to the owner or possessor of the illegally parked vehicle, or to both, for a violation of this section.”

Section 2. Subsections (a), (b), (d) and (e) of Section 94-60 “Prohibited parking of a vehicle within the front yard” are not changed, repealed or amended by this Ordinance, and continue in full force and effect as previously written, approved and ordained by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 3. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




