RESOLUTION NO. 2015-152

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING WELL WITHIN THE COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY ON THOMAS ROAD NEAR HIGHWAY 85; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (“GEPD”) has requested to install an environmental monitoring well on Thomas Road near Highway 85; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the monitoring well is to determine the extent of groundwater contamination from the adjacent BP gasoline station located at 8426 Highway 85; and

WHEREAS, the monitoring well will be installed approximately 30 feet below the surface and work will be performed by Envirorisk Consultants, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing GEPD to install an environmental monitoring well within the County right of way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the installation of an environmental monitoring well within County right of way on Thomas Road near Highway 85. The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.
