RESOLUTION NO. 2015-202

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT WITH FREESTYLE PRODUCTIONS, LLC PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH LIVE ENTERTAINMENT WILL BE PERFORMED AT CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County and Freestyle Productions, LLC (the “Promoter”) wish to enter into a Performance Agreement to provide live entertainment entitled, “Wind Down Thursdays” to be performed at the Clayton County International Park Amphitheater on Thursday, August 27, 2015 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Promoter will require and cause two bands and one deejay under the terms and conditions of the Agreement to set-up, sound check, and perform, and provide sound equipment and stage management; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Parks and Recreation Department has budgeted for the above performances and funds are available in support thereof; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into an agreement with the Promoter for the foregoing purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Performance Agreement with Freestyle Productions, LLC (the “Agreement”) to provide live entertainment at the Clayton County International Park Amphitheater on Thursday, August 27, 2015.

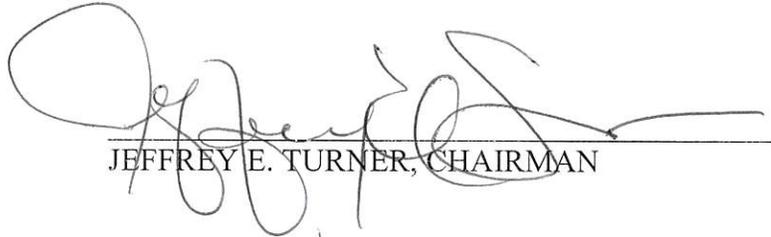
Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement attached hereto and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.

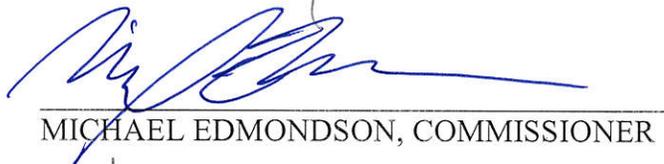

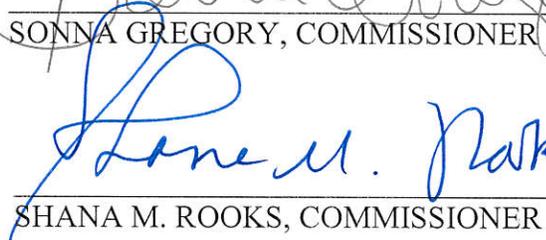
