RESOLUTION NO. 2015-68

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT ABANDONED PROPERTY PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 17-5-54(A)(1) AND SUPERIOR COURT ORDERS 2014-CV-05135-8 AND 2014-CV-05136-5 FOR OFFICIAL USE BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN, OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT THE PROPERTY ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 17-5-54(a)(1), the Clayton County Police Department did petition the Superior Court of Clayton County to allow the Department to retain certain abandoned property more fully described in the exhibits to Superior Court Orders, 2014-CV05135-8 AND 2014-CV-05136-5, and which exhibits and Orders are adopted by reference and incorporated into this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court did grant the petitions and issued two Orders, under Superior Court Case Numbers 2014-CV-05135-8 AND 2014-CV-05136-5, to retain said property for official use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by accepting property for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept certain property which is more fully described in the exhibits to the two Superior Court orders, 2014-CV-05135-8 AND 2014-CV-05136-5. These orders and their exhibits are hereby adopted by reference and incorporated into this Resolution. Said property, which is considered abandoned pursuant to OCGA § 17-5-54(a)(1), has been granted to the Police Department for official use by the Superior Court of Clayton County. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or the Chief of Police as his designee, to execute any documents necessary, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






