RESOLUTION NO. 2015-82

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO TWO GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE, FINANCIAL CRIMES TASK FORCE, PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS UNDER WHICH EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING WILL BE PURCHASED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENTS, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department was awarded a Grant from the United States Secret Service, Financial Crimes Task Force, to purchase equipment, and/or training in the amount of \$750.00, with no matching County funds required; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will be best served by participating in this grant and purchasing the equipment and/or training specified therein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTONCOUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute two grant agreements with the United States Secret Service, Financial Crimes Task Force, for the purchase of training and equipment to be purchased with no matching County funds and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to

amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreements.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
